- Date & Time of Screening Test: April 27 th, 2019 (SATURDAY) 10 AM to 11.30 AM.
- Announcement of results & display of merit list: April 28th, 2019.
- Commencement of admissions: May 1st, 2019.

### Screening Test Pattern:

- Eligibility for Appearing for Screening Test:
- Have 60% in Intermediate or +2
- Have to appear for Entrance test on Intermediate syllabus and have to qualify in the test.
- Entrance Test will be In the month of May 1<sup>st</sup> week- 2019.

Admission into B.Sc (CBZ)-Minimum 55% in Intermediate BiPC or +2

**Admission into B.Com -** Minimum 50% of any group. (MPC, MEC, CEC, HEC, BIPC & Vocational )

- Syllabus for Screening Test:
  - Mathematics Physics Chemistry & English of Two years Intermediate Level.
- Total Marks for the Screening Test: (60 Marks)
  (Maths-20 Physics -15 Chemistry 15 and English 10)
- Selection will be done considering Screening Test for 75% and Intermediate for Marks
  25%
- Model of Screening Test: Test will be contain 60 questions. (Fill in the blanks questions and Short answer questions.) each question carries 1 mark.
