Keeping this in view to provide an opportunity to admit meritorious students, it is proposed to conduct a common screening test for admission into highly demanded courses in B.Sc.- MPCs, MECs, MSCs and MPC from the academic year 2018-19

### **Important Dates**

- **Sale of Application** : from April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- **Last date for sale of applications and registration:** on or before April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- **Date & Time of Screening Test** : April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2018. (SATURDAY) 10 AM to 11.30AM.
- **Announcement of results & display of merit list** : April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
- **Commencement of admissions** : May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.

### **Screening Test Pattern:**

- **Eligibility for Appearing for Screening Test:** Students who completed 2 years Intermediate with MPC or any other equivalent examination recognized by the Board/University with 60% aggregate.
- **Syllabus for Screening Test:** Mathematics – Physics – Chemistry & English of Two years Intermediate Level.
- **Total Marks for the Screening Test:** 60 Marks (Maths-20 Physics -15 Chemistry – 15 and English – 10)
- Selection will be done considering Screening Test for 75% and Intermediate for Marks - 25%
- **Model of Screening Test:** Test will be contain 60 questions. (Fill in the blanks questions and Short answer questions.) each question carries 1 mark
